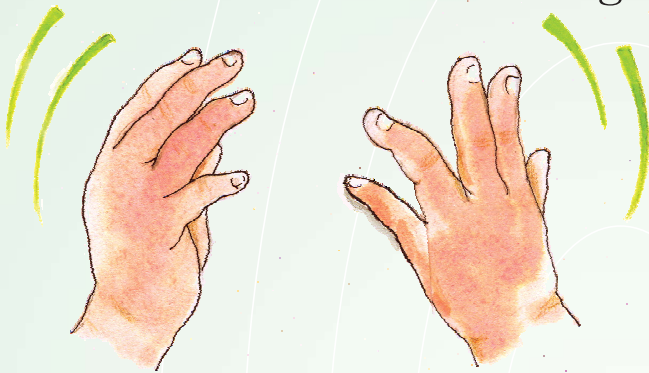
ACTION SONG

Sing with me today.

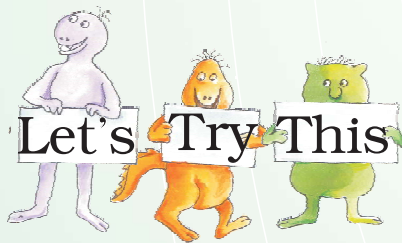
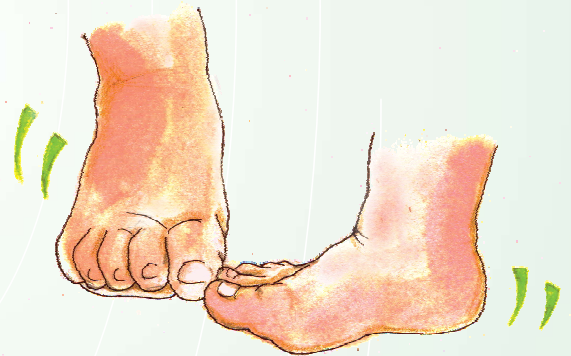
Wave your hand and clap clap clap,
